On 6th May our adult squad successfully retained the FA Disability Cup crown at St. George's Park. The FA Disability Cup ran for a second

successive year, providing a platform for the very best in impairment specific football in the country.

Five finals took place on the day, one being the cerebral palsy final that was showcased at the national football centre with hundreds watching on. CP United Seniors convincingly beat Chelsea Whites again to keep the cup in the North West. Another fantastic achievement, and something the club should be very proud of.

The club then capped off an unbelievable season by winning the 12th FECPC International Trophy in Barcelona beating Chile 2-1 in a nail biting final on Sunday 11th June.

The tournament got underway on the Thursday with two groups of four. In their first outing CP United ground out a 4-1 victory against Jordan. On day 2, CPU beat Austria 6-1 leaving the club the only team in group B on six points.

The final group games were played on the Saturday and it was a winner takes all scenario against Ireland as qualification depended on the head-to-head result. CPU victory against Ireland 6-0 ensured qualification to the final against pre-tournament favourites Chile.

The final didn't disappoint, despite the 31 degree heat, CP United dug out a victory to make history and cap off a fantastic season.
