This tournament will be held at Plume Secondary School, Cambridge Road, Maldon, Essex.

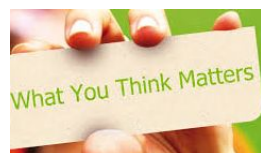
STAFFORD TOWN CP – July (date TBC)
