ADULT FIXTURES:

As you will all be aware by now we are not entering the CP Sport National League this season due to a change in structure and which would limit the game time and playing opportunities we get but increases the travel and time commitment involved. We had meetings with the players, committee and coaches and all had the same opinion that we will try something different this year in terms of arranging fixtures and trying to get as many opportunities for all players to play as possible. This will mean a mix of playing games v PAN disability teams, mainstream teams, CP specific teams and we are working hard to arrange those opportunities.

We will also entered the FA Peoples cup (which is a 5v5 competition) as well as the CP Sport National Cup.

We are also looking at tournaments to enter at the end of the season to access more competition for our players. Unfortunately the league wasn't a fit for us this year due to the structure, but we will try our best to sort out as many games as possible. During this process we ask for your patience as some games we won't know the level of competition until we have tried it. Change is messy sometimes and doing things a little differently is also a challenge but it's ok to try something different and the decisions that have been made are for the right reasons. As coaches we are looking forward to a productive season with our adults program and sticking together and working hard is key.

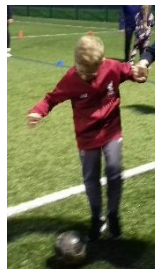
