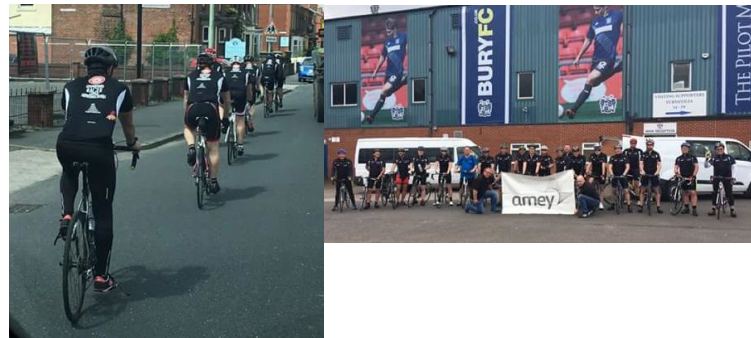
Very well done to Ben and we are sure he will be a fantastic ambassador for our club whilst he is carrying out his duties with CP Sport.
